The vines struggle in soil comprised of well-worn river rock located a short distance from the current route of the Rogue River, just 20 miles north of the California-Oregon border. Whole-cluster pressed rosé of Grenache from this beautiful site results in a wine with aromatics of flint, strawberry, and grapefruit. Fermented in a stainless-steel tank, this intentionally dry style of rosé has the structure to hold up to your favorite grilled foods. 120 cases produced.
